To collect data for the Unwrapped 2024 report, volunteer Plastic Investigators from all around the country looked at prices in the fresh produce section of their local supermarket.

In 73% of cases, the pre-packaged option was cheaper than the loose option.

This disincentivises shoppers from buying plastic-free and only what they need.
